# ***Victim Services***



## Who is a Victim?

- Anyone whose life has been affected by trauma, tragedy or disaster, regardless of the severity
- Someone whose personal rights have been violated by criminal, violent, or aggressive acts



- Family and friends of a person who has been injured or killed as a result of a crime or tragic circumstance
- Someone who has viewed, or been present, during a violent or traumatic event

### Family Court Support

If you are currently in, or will be going through the family court process and are a victim of domestic violence, The Family Court Support Program can help

### Vulnerable Persons Database

The VPD will offer assistance to anyone who is vulnerable or at risk in a crisis or emergency situation. This would include individuals who are at risk of wandering, in need of medical assistance in a natural disaster/power outage or any other crisis that may pose a risk to their wellbeing.

### Victim Quick Response Program

The VQRP is designed to help victims of violent crimes with immediate financial assistance. VQRP can cover short-term counselling, funeral expenses, home safety, and other short-term assistance

## What is Victim Services?

- Victim Services is a non-profit community based organization working in partnership with Police, Fire, Emergency Services and other social service agencies to meet the short term needs of victims of crime, tragic circumstances and loss by providing emotional support, practical assistance and referrals to community resources.



- Help victims of crime and sudden tragedies restore and enhance their quality of life while working to prevent further victimization
- Victim Services offers crisis intervention services 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.
